Kuching City

Honoured as one of South East Asia's cleanest cities, Kuching, Sarawak's capital, is an idyllic city characterized by hilly landscape, riverine lowland and vast greenery at almost every corner! The majestic colonial buildings dating from the time of the White Rajahs remain imposing in the old part of the city, just a stone's throw away from the new high rise Central Business District, and the two parts are joined by the most popular tourist spot – the Kuching Waterfront. Shopping, eateries and entertainment spots abound within this area with hotels, banks and a ride across the river using a river taxi (sampan) always an exhilarating experience.

Kuching, which is one of the largest cities in area in Malaysia, comes under the jurisdiction of three councils and each offers something different for visitors. You can reach the nearest beach in less than an hour drive, internationally award winning Living Museum of cultural heritage and experience white water canoeing or climb limestone cliffs, all just in close proximity. Nature lovers will find the orang utan sanctuary thrilling and trekking in tropical forest in the national parks a welcome escape from the city scene.

Foremost, visitors will find the city a place of smiles as that's second nature to the multi ethnic, cultural and religious city folks who make Kuching home. The city is also the main gateway to other parts of the state and the main administrative centre, a city that welcomes people from all over the world for business, pleasure, health care and more!

Venue

The Borneo Convention Centre Kuching is Sarawak's first purpose-built international convention centre. Opened in 2009 to grow business tourism for the state, it has since welcomed more than 3,000 events and over 4 million visitors from around the world.

Just 15 minutes from Kuching city and bordered by the Sarawak River, BCCK's Ririk leaf inspired roof and rainforest themed interiors reflect its home on Borneo while keeping sustainability at the heart of the design. Inside, a spacious Great Hall, flexible meeting rooms and a bright riverside concourse make it easy to move from high-level plenaries to technical sessions, exhibitions and relaxed networking with a view.

Over the past 16 years, BCCK has hosted conferences in medicine, engineering, renewable energy, sustainability and more, including ICCA, WCIT, IAIA, APNCC and the World Congress of Herpetology. Many of these events return to Kuching because delegates remember the combination of serious content, warm Sarawak hospitality and a setting that feels different from a typical city convention centre.

Coming 2028

To meet growing demand, BCCK is expanding with BCCK2, targeted for completion in early 2028. Together, BCCK and BCCK2 will form a connected convention campus that is roughly double the current size, with capacity for up to 15,000 people across plenary sessions, exhibitions and social events.

The expanded centre will feature a new large main hall, an additional multi-purpose hall and 34 breakout rooms for concurrent streams, workshops and closed-door meetings. A linked riverside concourse, upgraded car park and an extended Raintree Restaurant Deck will complete the experience, giving organisers more room to grow their events while keeping everything within a walkable, Borneo inspired setting.



About

Borneo International Water & Wastewater Exhibition & Conference 2026 (BIWWEC)

BIWWEC is Sarawak's homegrown international congregation of water and wastewater experts, convening leaders, innovators, and practitioners biennially under the organisation of the Malaysian Water Association (MWA) Sarawak Branch.

Formerly known as Borneo Water & Wastewater Exhibition (BWWE), it was an initiative of the Malaysian Water Association, first organised in 2010 in conjunction with the Water Safety Plan Conference. Over the years, it has attracted participants from a diverse range of countries, including Australia, Britain, Cambodia, China, Germany, India, Indonesia, Iran, Japan, Malaysia, the Netherlands, the Philippines, Singapore, Spain, the United Kingdom, the United States of America, and Vietnam, among others.

With the theme "Regional Partnerships for a Climate-Ready Water Future", BIWWEC 2026 emphasises the power of collaboration across borders and sectors to tackle pressing water challenges in an era of climate uncertainty. The conference will serve as a dynamic platform to foster joint strategies, share innovations, and strengthen partnerships that advance water security and resilience for communities across Borneo and the wider ASEAN region.

Sponsorship Terms And Conditions

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 These terms and conditions and the Sponsorship Form to which they are attached set out the terms on which you (the Sponsor) agree to sponsor the Event. Please read the Agreement carefully and make sure you understand it before signing. You understand that by signing the Sponsorship Form, you agree to be bound by the terms of the Agreement.
- 1.2 References to "us", "we", and "our" shall refer to the Organiser, and references to "you" and "your" shall refer to the Sponsor.

2. GRANT OF RIGHTS

- 2.1 We grant to you:
 - 2.1.1 The Sponsorship Rights (as defined in the Sponsorship Prospectus); and
 - 2.1.2 a non-transferable, non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use the Event logos and trademarks (the "Event Marks") provided to you in accordance with clause 3.4 solely to promote your sponsorship of the Event, during the Term (as defined in clause 6.1) and in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
- 2.2 You grant to us a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, sub-licensable license to use your logos and trademarks (the "Sponsor Marks") provided to us in accordance with clause 3.3:
 - 2.2.1 during the Term to promote and exploit the Event; and
 - 2.2.2 for a period of six months following the Event in any report produced about the Event and in any promotional materials for similar events.
- 2.3 In the event that you change the Sponsor Marks at any time during the Term, you agree that we shall not be obliged to make any consequential changes to materials that include the Sponsor Marks produced by us or on our behalf for or in connection with the Event (including, but not limited to, reprinting promotional literature or publicity materials) unless you agree in writing in advance to meet the costs and expenses incurred by us arising from such change.
- 2.4 If for any reason we are unable to deliver any of the Sponsorship Rights, we will inform you as soon as reasonably practicable. We may substitute alternative benefits in respect of the same Event to an equivalent value of the relevant Sponsorship Rights without any liability to you.
- 2.5 You acknowledge and agree that you shall be solely responsible for all costs that you incur relating to your attendance at the Event (including, without limitation, any travel costs, the costs of any temporary staff and any costs relating to the stand that you erect at the Event).
- 2.6 You shall promptly comply with all reasonable instructions and directions issued by or on behalf of us in connection with the Event and its promotion (including, without limitation, any instructions or directions given in relation to the use of the venue at which the Event is being held). We shall not be responsible for any failure or delay in providing any of the Sponsorship Rights where such failure occurs directly or indirectly as a result of your failure or delay in complying with any of our reasonable instructions or directions.

3. YOUR OBLIGATIONS

- 3.1 You undertake to support the Event through appropriate marketing and promotional channels and to collaborate with us on any appropriate joint marketing or promotional projects relating to the Event.
- 3.2 You undertake to exercise the Sponsorship Rights in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
- 3.3 You shall, within seven days of signature of this Agreement by both parties, supply us with examples of the Sponsor Marks in a suitable format.
- 3.4 You shall, prior to distributing any promotional materials referencing the Event and/or using the Event Marks (the "Sponsor Materials") provide copies of the Sponsor Materials to us for our approval (not to be unreasonably withheld). You undertake that you shall not distribute any Sponsor Materials until you have received written confirmation from us that we approve the Sponsor Materials. You are solely responsible for meeting all costs relating to the Sponsor Materials, (including reprinting costs if our approvals are not obtained prior to printing.

- 3.5 You undertake to exercise the Sponsorship Rights in accordance with the terms of this Agreement.
- 3.6 You shall, within seven days of signature of this Agreement by both parties, supply us with examples of the Sponsor Marks in a suitable format.
- 3.7 You shall, prior to distributing any promotional materials referencing the Event and/or using the Event Marks (the "Sponsor Materials") provide copies of the Sponsor Materials to us for our approval (not to be unreasonably withheld). You undertake that you shall not distribute any Sponsor Materials until you have received written confirmation from us that we approve the Sponsor Materials. You are solely responsible for meeting all costs relating to the Sponsor Materials, (including reprinting costs if our approval is not obtained prior to printing).
- 3.8 You undertake that any Sponsor Materials will:
- 3.8.1 comply, without limitation, with all relevant laws and regulations in force that relate to the promotion of the Event;
 - 3.8.2 comply with any instructions or directions issued by or on behalf of us;
 - 3.8.3 not contravene any applicable law, infringe the rights of any third party or contain any inaccuracies of fact; and
 - 3.8.4 include any legal or good practice notices as required by us from time to time.

4. OUR OBLIGATIONS

- 4.1 In addition to the license granted at clause 2.1, we shall provide the Sponsorship Rights and organize the Event using reasonable skill and care and will consult with the Sponsor Representative (as set out on the Sponsorship Form) on aspects of the Event where we deem it appropriate to do so.
- 4.2 The Sponsorship Rights are personal to you, and we are not obliged to provide the Sponsorship Rights (or any part of them) to any other entity or person.

5. SPONSORSHIP FEE

- 5.1 In consideration of us providing the Sponsorship Rights, you shall pay to us the Sponsorship Fee (as set out on the Sponsorship Form) in accordance with the Payment Period (as set out on the Sponsorship Form).
- 5.2 If the Sponsorship Fee is not received by us when due, we reserve the right not to supply, or cease to supply, any or all of the Sponsorship Rights.
- 5.3 The sponsorship form must be returned to us on 29th MAY 2026. (Any late order, surcharge will be imposed).

6. TERM AND TERMINATION

- 6.1 This Agreement shall take effect on the date that the last party signs the Sponsorship Form and shall continue until the completion of the Event (the "Term"), unless terminated early in accordance with its terms.
- 6.2 Either party has the right at any time to terminate this Agreement immediately by giving written notice to the other in the event that the other:
 - 6.2.1 has committed a material breach of any of its obligations under this Agreement (including failure to pay any amounts due under this Agreement) and has not remedied any such breach (if capable of remedy) within fourteen (14) days of being required to do so by written notice
- 6.3 Termination of this Agreement by either party for any reason shall be without prejudice to any rights or obligations that may have accrued as at the date of such termination.
- 6.4 Upon termination of this Agreement by us in accordance with this clause 6, all outstanding sums owing to us at the date of termination shall become due and payable without deduction or set off. Where termination occurs before you have received all the Sponsorship Rights, we shall charge you such proportion of the Sponsorship Fee (calculated in good faith) as is reasonable to reflect the value of the Sponsorship Rights received by you prior to the date of termination.
- 6.5 Upon expiry or termination of this Agreement, the parties agree that:
 - 6.5.1 our obligations to provide any further Sponsorship Rights shall cease;
 - 6.5.2 any licenses granted pursuant to this Agreement shall immediately cease.

7. CONFIDENTIALITY

- 7.1 Each party shall treat in confidence all information obtained from the other pursuant to this Agreement that is confidential in nature (which shall include details of the Sponsorship Fee) and shall use such confidential information solely for the purpose of exercising its rights or performing its obligations under this Agreement.
- 7.2 Each party shall only disclose such confidential information: (i) to those of its employees who may reasonably need to know the same to the extent required for the proper performance of this Agreement; and (ii) to the extent that such confidential information is required to be disclosed by law.

8. FORCE MAJEURE

- 8.1 "Force Majeure" means any circumstances beyond the reasonable control of either Party (including, without limitations, any governmental action, act of God, strike, terrorism, lockout or other forms of industrial action).
- 8.2 If any Party is affected by the Force Majeure which affects or may affect the performance of any of its obligations under this Agreement, it shall forthwith notify the other Party of its nature and extent.
- 8.3 No Party shall be deemed to be in breach of this Agreement, or otherwise be liable to the other Party, by reason of any delay in performance, or the non-performance, of any of its obligations hereunder, to the extent that the delay or non-performance is due to any Force Majeure of which it has notified the other Party, and the time for performance of that obligation shall be extended accordingly.

9. CANCELLATION

- 9.1 The Organiser reserves the right to cancel, postpone or reschedule events due to government restrictions or unforeseen circumstances. In case of cancellation of BIWWEC 2026, a full refund will be made within 14 days via the same method payment was made, unless requested otherwise.

10. GENERAL

- 10.1 This Agreement contains the entire agreement and understanding between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings or arrangements (both oral and written) relating to the subject matter of this Agreement.
- 10.2 You acknowledge that you have not relied on, and shall have no remedy in respect of, any statement, representation, warranty, understanding, promise or assurance (whether negligently or innocently made) of any person other than as expressly set out in this Agreement.
- 10.3 This Agreement shall not create, nor shall it be construed as creating, any partnership or agency relationship between the parties.

Rules & Regulations for Build-up and Dismantle

1. ATTIRE

All Exhibitor's personnel or Contractors must be properly attired. No slippers or singlets will be allowed during build-up & dismantle period.

2. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

The Organiser/ Officer Service Contractor shall not be liable safety and security of Exhibitors, their personnel/ employees, representatives or contractors nor for any exhibits, materials, machinery, documents or other property of whatever kind brought into the Exhibition venue at any time during the build-up and dismantle period.

The Organiser / Officer Service Contractor shall not in any event be held responsible for any restriction or conditions which prevent the construction, erection, completion, alteration or dismantling of stands or the entry, siting or removal of exhibits or for the failure of any services or amenities provided by the venue landlords or their third parties.

3. EXHIBITOR'S / CONTRACTOR'S INSURANCE

Exhibitors / Contractors shall make sure they are fully covered by insurance including, but not restricted to, all risks on their property, exhibits or article of any kind, public liability and comprehensive protection against any loss or damage caused by any circumstances whatsoever whether by reason of fire, water, theft, accident or any other causes. The Exhibitor shall insure against, indemnify and hold the Organiser / Officer Service Contractor harmless in respect of all costs, claims, demands and expenses to which the Organiser may in any way be subjected as a result of any loss or injury arising to any person (including members of the public or the Organiser's staff, agents or contractors) or property howsoever caused. If the Organiser demands the Exhibitor shall provide proof to the Organiser that the Exhibitor has adequate insurance cover.

Exhibitors must ensure that their staff , agents or contractors are insured against claims for workman's compensation. The period for which such insurance shall be maintained shall run from the time the Exhibitor or any of his staff, agents or contractors first enters the exhibition grounds until he has vacated the exhibition grounds and all his exhibits and property have been removed.

4. GROUP STANDS

Contracting parties for group stands and national groups are responsible for ensuring that all Exhibitors within their group are fully aware of, and agree to abide by the Rules & Regulations of the Exhibit.

5. SAFETY & SECURITY

All personnel involved in the build-up and dismantle in the exhibition halls must wear identification badges at all times.

Security guards will patrol the exhibition site in general, but their duties will not include specific attention to individual stands.

The Organiser/ Officer Service Contractor reserves the right to request any of the Exhibitor's personnel, or contractors to stop work if they should in any way cause disorder/ chaos, discomfort or threaten the safety and smooth proceedings of the build-up and dismantle in any manner whatsoever.

6. STANDARD SHELL SCHEME BOOTH (3mx3m)

Booking for each 9 sq.m booth will be provided with standard fittings as follows:

- Rear and dividing wall partition of 2.44m/ 8ft high, aluminium system and 3mm white panel.
- One Fascia board with company name and booth number
- One unit of reception desk
- Two units of folding chair
- One unit of waste paper basket
- Two units of fluorescent light
- One unit of 13amp/240v single phase power point

There will be no discounts on any items replaced/ omitted.

There will be certain charges imposed by the Officer Service Contractor for any removal / additional items to the booth.

Drilling or nailing on the booth structure or panel is not permitted.

Any form of graffiti/ sticker/ painting on the booth panel is not allowed. Exhibitors who wish to do any changes to the standard booth may deal directly with the Officer Service Contractor.

Exhibitors setting up/ decorating their own booths undertake full responsibility for any damages which may be done by any of their employees including appointed sub-contractors at the Exhibitions hall.

7. STAND FITTING / CONSTRUCTION

Exhibitors are encouraged to use the Officer Service Contractor to do their build-up. However they may opt to appoint their own contractor to undertake the construction of their booth. The electrical installation must be carried out by the Officer Service Contractor.

All Exhibitors must seek approval from the Organiser for any exhibits that exceed **2.44m / 8ft** in height.

For Special Design Booth, the maximum height is **4m**.

Exhibitors are responsible and liable for their contractor's observance of all Rules & Regulations, including the strict observance of the build-up and dismantle schedule.

The Organiser reserves the right to charge any Exhibitor and / or contractor who has violated any rules or regulations or delay in the build-up or dismantlement and for additional works required as a result of the violation.

All non-official stand contractors are required to place a refundable deposit of RM100.00 per square meter per booth with the Officer Service Contractor to serve as a performance bond as well as a damage deposit.

A non-refundable administration fee of RM60.00 per square meter per booth is payable by the Exhibitor's contractor to the Officer Service Contractor prior to commencing works. The Exhibitor undertakes to ensure that their contractor adheres to this requirement. This fee is for the general administration by the Officer Service Contractor throughout the build-up and dismantle period.

The Organiser / Officer Service Contractor shall not be responsible in whatsoever manner and on whatever ground for any delay caused by the Exhibitors' contractors in failing to comply with those terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Venue Provider.

All Exhibitors constructing their own booth must submit a detailed drawing with dimensions illustrating the design of their booth to the Officer Service Contractor and Organiser for approval.

At the end of the Exhibition, the Exhibitor must ensure either itself or its contractor dismantles and removes the booth/ exhibits including debris in accordance with the dismantling schedule.

* All exhibitors must comply with Sarawak Labour Ordinance regarding the employment of workers from outside Sarawak. For further information, please check with Immigration Department or Sarawak Immigration and Labour Management Unit.

8. GENERAL STAND CONSTRUCTION RULES

No person under any circumstances shall cut into or through any floor covering or wall nor alter any stand structure. Any such damage to stand structures or exhibition premises will be invoiced to the exhibitor / their contractor.

NO welding, heavy sawing, suspension from the exhibition hall ceiling structure, nailing, drilling or fixing onto the floor is allowed. This includes any column, wall or any other part of the venue.

DO NOT use the back panel of a wall or neighboring stand to put up decoration and act as support , any sign or company name.

All back wall facing out or to other booth must be painted white. No ugly structure are shown.

Exhibitors may not place any display materials and exhibits on or construct a dividing wall or any part their stand design and fitting beyond their contracted boundary.

All other constructions, installations or activities carried out, apart from those agreed in the sales package, shall be at the expense and responsibility of the Exhibitor, and be done in such a manner as to cause no unnecessary disturbance or disruption to the activities of the other users of the venue.

9. ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION

Power points supplied are used for running equipment/ exhibits only. If used for lighting purposes, lighting connection charges will apply.

Multi socket points are strictly prohibited to avoid any overloading as this may lead to a trip in the incoming power supply and cause damage and inconvenience to other exhibitors. Exhibitors whose electrical fixtures are found to have been the cause of trips in power supply will be responsible for all re-connection charges.

All lighting connection work must be done by the Official Electrician. Without exception, Exhibitors including those who provide their own lighting fixtures will be charged the lighting connection rate as per the order form.

10. CLEANING/ RUBBISH REMOVAL

During the build up and dismantle periods Exhibitors and their contractors must be responsible for the removal of their own stand building/ dismantling materials and rubbish. Debris must not be deposited into the venue's garbage or disposal bins. All construction debris from the booths/ stands after build up / dismantling must be cleared before the Officer Service Contractor takes over the responsibility.

11. DANGEROUS MATERIALS

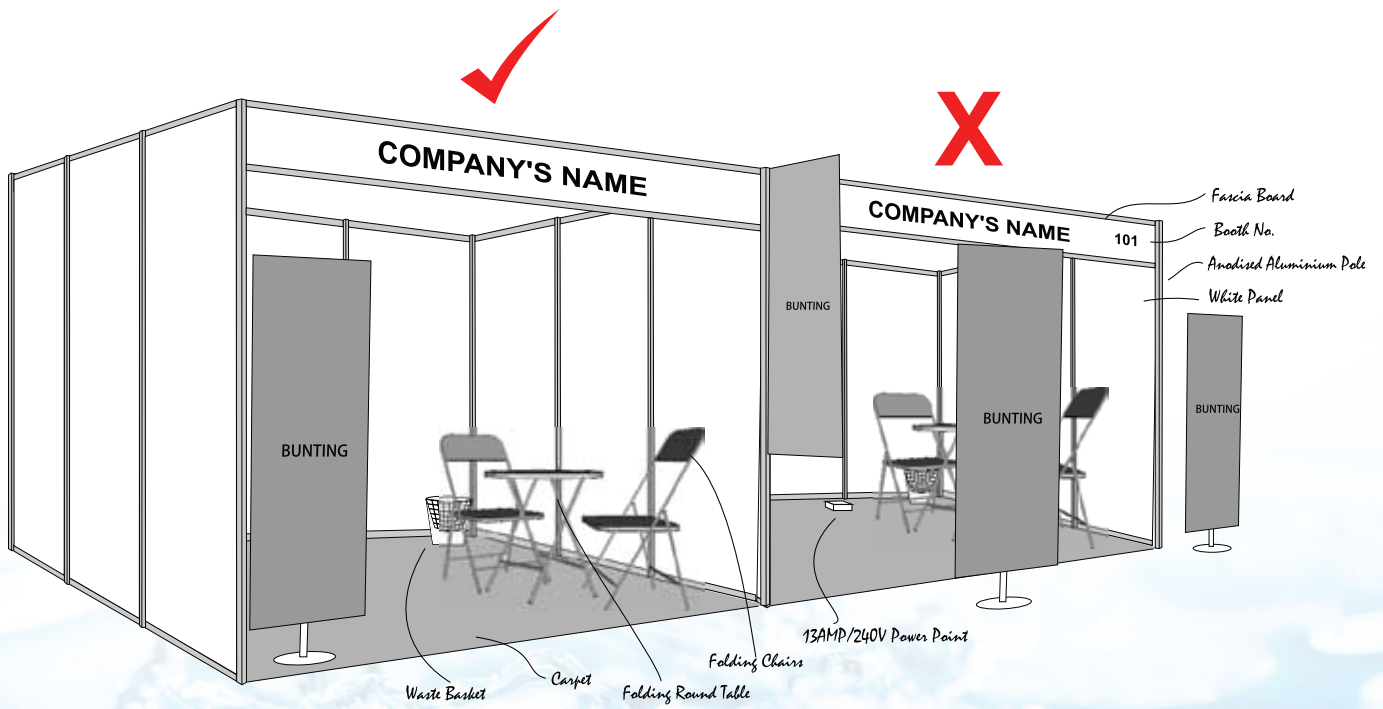
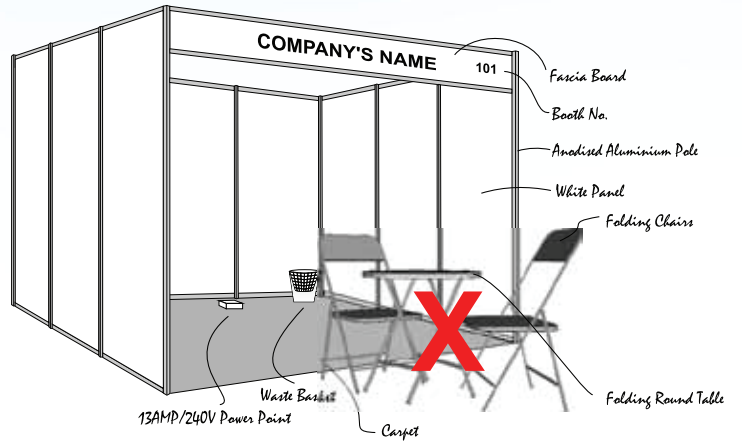
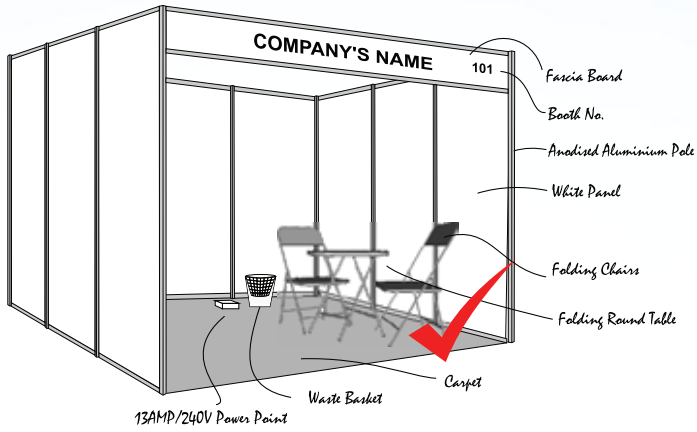
